PARISH HOME CATECHISM PROGRAM — Children attending public, private or alternative school are required to participate in this program from grade 1 - 7 in order to prepare to receive the sacraments.

The Peace of Christ be with you all!

We celebrate this Sunday the Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time. On the First Reading, from the Book of Wisdom, we see how important God's wisdom is to make right decisions in our daily lives. It is a gift that God wants to pour out upon us. It is the capacity to discern and to carry out God's will in all circumstances of our lives. If we do so, with we find happiness and fulfillment. In the Second Reading from the Letter to the Hebrews, it shows how powerful and life-giving is God's word. If we are attached to our goods and richness, we are unable to follow Him, but if we enter into His plan and follow Him, we will find immense joy and happiness.



This weekend we celebrate Thanksgiving. Let us be grateful to God for all the gifts that we have received from Him. We should be especially thankful for the gift of

our lives, our families; but most of all, for the gift of faith and for the immense gift of Christ giving Himself to us so that we may find abundant life. Let us be grateful for all the blessing that we have received in our lives!

### **Archdiocese of Toronto - Proof of Vaccination**
