

FOURTH SUNDAY IN ADVENT

Message from the Pastor

The Peace of Christ be with you all!

We celebrate this Sunday the Fourth Sunday of Advent. This Sunday brings us at the door of Christmas. On the First Reading from the Book of the prophet Micah, presents a prophecy in which the Lord is going to be born in Bethlehem of Judea. We all know that this prophecy became fulfilled in Christ.
