OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Message from the Pastor

Peace to all of you!

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe. The First Reading, from the Book of the prophet Daniel, we are presented with a prophecy on which the Son of Man (prefiguration of Christ) receives from God kingship, power, and sovereignty over all peoples. We all know that this prophecy is fulfilled in Christ since, with His Glorification and Ascension into Heaven, He is the King of the Universe. He has power to intervene in our lives so that we may be transformed, and we can share with Him in Eternal Life. The Second Reading, from the Book of Revelation, it shows how Jesus Christ becomes the Glorious King after His Death and Resurrection. He has forgiven all our sins and has transformed us so that we share the abundant life that He offers us. We are called to be open and to welcome His transformative mercy in our hearts. In the Gospel, from St. John, we see what kind of king is Christ the Lord. It is given to us a portion of the dialogue between Pilate and Jesus that took place at the Passion. Pilate is amazed to see what kind of King Christ is. He thought that a King was supposed to be forceful, dominant, and strong. Yet, Christ is another kind of King: a merciful, generous, and forgiving one. The kingship of Christ consists in giving His life for us, forgiving us and giving His life for us so that we may have life to the fullest. His throne is the Cross, from which He has destroyed our sins and share with us Eternal Life. The power of Christ lays in being merciful, giving His life for us, and loving us unconditionally. Let us open our hearts so that we may share in His Kingship of love, mercy, peace, and care for the others!

The Advent Season begins next week

The Catholic Church Liturgical Year starts with the 1st Sunday of Advent on December 1, 2024

Advent is a time of preparation for the coming of Christ at Christmas. Latin "adventus" (Preparation)
Marks the four Sundays before Christmas

Advent Wreaths

Part of our spiritual preparation for Christmas. Christ is "the Light that came into the world" to dispel the darkness of sin and to radiate the truth and love of God (John 3:19-21).

- \cdot The wreath is made of various evergreens, signifying continuous life.
- · The circle of the wreath, which has no beginning or end, symbolizes the everlasting life found in Christ.
- · The four candles represent the four weeks of Advent.

 The purple candles symbolize the prayer, penance, and preparatory sacrifices and goods works undertaken at this time.

 The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday which is called Gaudete Sunday. It is the Sunday of rejoicing, because the faithful have

arrived at the midpoint of Advent, when their preparation is now half over, and they are close to Christmas.

· Only one purple candle is lit during the first week, two in the second week, three (incl. the pink one) in the third week, and all four during the fourth week of Advent

The gradually increasing light symbolizes the approach of Christmas, the birth of Jesus, the light of the world.

 \cdot <u>A fifth candle (white)</u> can be added in the middle of the wreath for Christmas

Eve and Day (or replace all four purple and pink candles with white ones) symbolizing the arrival of Christ, the light of the world. Light the white candle(s) until The Baptism of the Lord.

Families are encouraged to observe Advent by gathering around a wreath for brief Advent prayers and readings lighting the appropriate number of candles for each week.

Traditions assign specific symbolism to each of the candles:

- 1) The Prophet's Candle, symbolizing Hope
- 2) The Bethlehem Candle, symbolizing Love & Faith
- 3) The Shepherd's Candle, symbolizing Joy
- 4) The Angel's Candle, symbolizing Peace.


